SELECTION CRITERIA

1. To be eligible for NJHS Aurora Chapter membership the candidate must be a sixth or seventh grade student at Clark Middle School.
2. Candidate must have a cumulative scholastic average of 3.5 to apply for membership and must maintain a 3.5 average once he/ she is a member.
3. Candidates must demonstrate the five pillars of NJHS:

Scholarship - A commitment to learning and academic success.

Service - Willingness to work for the benefit of those in need, without seeking compensation or recognition.

Leadership - Exerting a positive influence on the school and community, taking initiative in class and school activities. Remember, you don't have to be in charge of an activity to demonstrate leadership qualities.

Citizenship - Living up to the democratic ideals given to us by the founders of our country. How are you committed to your city, state, and/ or nation?

Character - The force within each individual which distinguishes that person from others. Who are you when no one is looking? How do you embody respect, responsibility, trustworthiness, fairness, and caring?

PRIOR TO SELECTION, THE FOLLOWING SHALL OCCUR:

- a. Students' academic and discipline records shall be reviewed to determine scholastic eligibility.
- b. Students who are eligible scholastically (candidates) shall be notified by **March 10** and asked to complete and submit the "Student Application Packet" for further consideration for selection.
 - The application packet will include a Student Information Form, Teacher Recommendations, and a Written Essay. Applications will be due **March 25 by 3pm.**
- c. The Faculty Council shall review the "Student Application Packet" in order to determine membership then extend invitations to selected candidates and their families to attend the induction ceremony on **April 6 at 8:30 am.**
